



INSTRUCTIONS AND INFORMATION

Thanks for buying a ticket to attend this year's Scarefest. We're so happy you're coming! This is your intro info packet, and should tell you everything you need to know to plan your gaming experience. FIRST THINGS FIRST.

You bought a ticket, so you need to sign up for games! For most of our games, you'll need to sign up in advance on Warhorn: <https://warhorn.net/events/asheville-scarefest>

****Please note: If you're pre-buying your ticket before September, our Warhorn sign-up may not yet be open. Never fear, go ahead and make your account and we'll notify you as soon as it's open.**

ARRIVING AT AVL SCAREFEST

Montreat Conference Center is located at 401 Assembly Drive, Montreat, NC. The convention is in **Freeland Hall**. Check the map attached to the end of this missive. You can technically park anywhere you can find in Montreat, but there's parking relatively close to the gaming hall marked on the map. There will be signs directing you both to parking and to the gaming hall.

Once you get into the gaming hall, there will be a Registration table immediately to your left as you enter. Make sure to stop and pick up your badge and registration packet (if you bought a meal ticket, t-shirt, or dice you'll get that stuff at Registration, too, along with your key if you purchased lodging at the Winsborough). **Read the info** in your registration packet. We know it's a pain to have to read stuff when all you want to do is get out your dice and get rolling, but it's sort of important information. Plus, there's a scavenger hunt during the Sunday morning brunch session, and the clues are hidden in there.

LODGING

If you purchased lodging at the Winsborough, you'll need to come down and get your key at Registration upon arrival, and then you can get into your room. The Winsborough is marked on the map at the end of this missive, and parking is just above it.

FOOD

You are welcome to bring your own food and drink to the gaming hall (but no alcohol, please...that has to wait for the afterparty at the Winsborough). The Wyvern's Tale will also be selling snacks and drinks on site. For mealtimes, please note that the nearest restaurants are a solid 10 minutes away, and our lunch break in particular is only 30 minutes long. So consider getting a meal ticket (available on our website) or packing sandwiches or other pre-prepared food you can keep with you all day.
